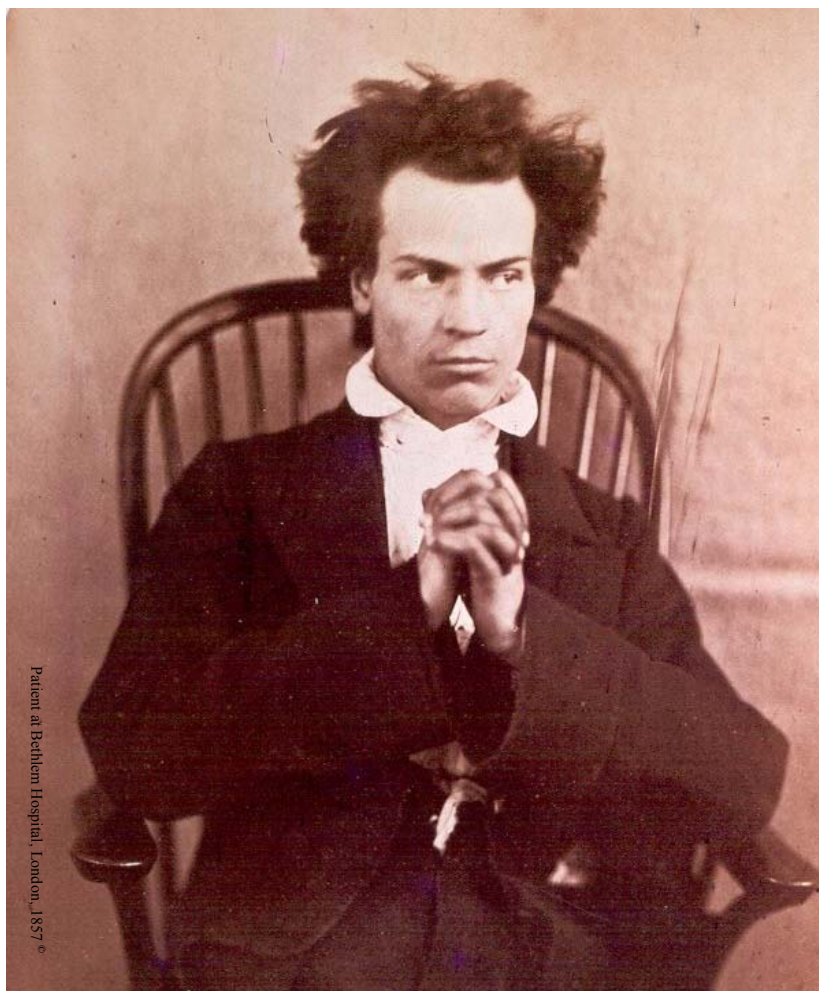

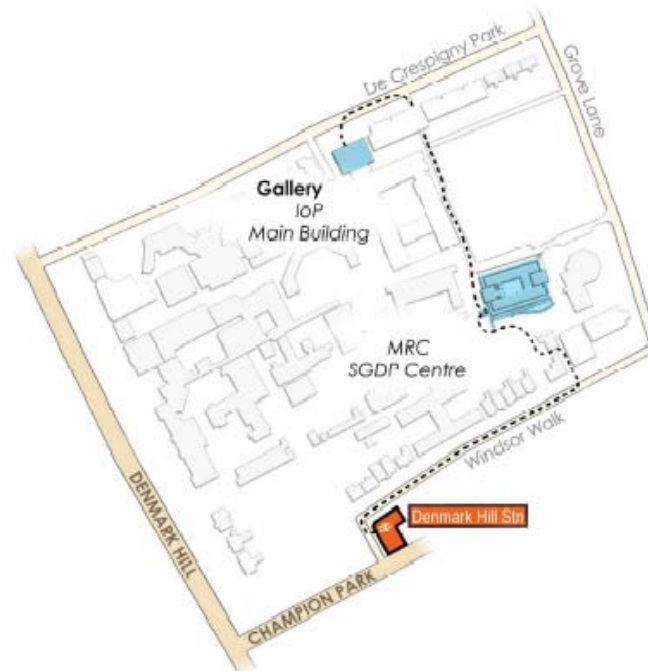
**Directions from Denmark Hill station:** At the station exit turn right down Windsor Walk. Make your way to building number 4 Windsor Walk. Walk up to the building entrance; to your left you will see a footpath called Memory Lane. Follow this past the MRC SGDP Centre until you reach the IoP Gallery in the main building

**Tube:** Oval, Elephant & Castle are nearest. Both have direct bus links.

**Bus:** Buses 40, 68, 176, 185, 468, 484 stop on Denmark Hill. Camberwell Green is 5 minutes walk

**Parking:** is not possible within the Institute grounds. Nearby streets have restricted parking facilities
